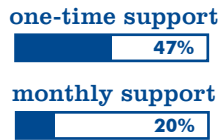
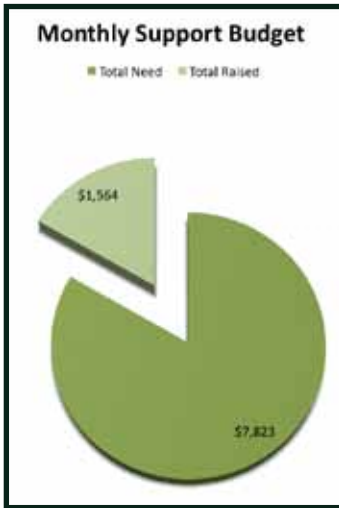

HOW CAN YOU HELP US?

We knew that by getting married our budget for Germany would nearly double. Our hope, dream and desire is to be in Germany by March 2011, and yes, we are far from our target. Right now we are only at 20% of our sustaining support committed and need at least 65% more. We need you, our friends and family to commit to sustaining us monthly. We are asking you to please consider and pray about supporting us at \$25, \$50 or \$100+ a month for the next two years. I know this can be a big commitment, but just like our God will provide for us, we know and believe God will take care of you too. If you do not have somewhere to send your tithes and/or have wanted to give back to God an offering in some way, please think of us. Right

now the holidays are a perfect time to give back. The best Christmas gift you can give us is to send us a little card that says "I Commit to Supporting You!" If you



cannot commit to support us for two years, please consider one year. If you can't commit to supporting us monthly but still want to help us, we also need one-time donations. We need about \$6,500 more for our one-time donation budget. This budget will help us make the initial move to Germany (including visas, plane tickets, a bed, etc.) while the monthly support will sustain us and the ministry while we are in Germany.
