A DVD projector was generously provided for HIV/AIDS education in the bush. Currently, Joseph holds seminars in various locations throughout Ngare Naibor reaching hundreds with this HIV/AIDS video.

CCCT (COMMUNITY CHRISTIAN CHURCH OF TANZANIA)

The church's registration is sitting on the Tanzanian President's desk awaiting his approval. Tanzania just

completed its elections, and we are now praying that this long-awaited approval process will be brought to closure.

Every month new churches are being started with the help of our church planters. Pray that this church movement will continue to spread throughout all of Tanzania and its unreached people groups.

Annelle and I will be returning to the US for one year for our furlough/home assignment. Our plan is to receive further training as needed, spend time with family, take time for rest, see as many of you as possible, and visit all our supporting churches. We have many exciting things to share with you and as the time gets closer, will be contacting you.
